

## Abstract Submission Guidelines

Authors are invited to contribute to the 1st International Conference on Sustainable Energy Systems (iCoSES 2025), which will be held online from **24 to 26 April 2025**. Abstracts must be submitted no later than **28 February 2025** through the official [Microsoft CMT](#) platform.

### ♣ Submission Requirements

Abstracts should be concise and focus on the key novelty of the work. Authors are encouraged to carefully review the conference topics and subtopics and select the area most relevant to their research. Each abstract must be written in English and should include the following sections:

- **Full Paper Title:** Provide a clear and descriptive title.
- **Author Information:** Include the full name, affiliation, address, email, and phone number of the corresponding author.
- **Conference Topic and Subtopic:** Indicate the topic and subtopic number (e.g., 1.2) with a brief justification for your choice.
- **Abstract Summary:** Present a concise overview of the work, including objectives, methodology, and results.
- **Aim and Approach Used:** Describe the main objectives and the methodology applied in the research.
- **Scientific Innovation and Relevance:** Highlight the novelty and importance of the research in the context of sustainable energy systems.
- **Results or Preliminary Results and Conclusions:** Summarize key findings and their implications.

*Note: Abstracts applying for journal publication must meet the minimum length requirement of 2–3 pages, formatted as specified below.*

### ♣ Formatting Guidelines

Abstracts must adhere to the following formatting rules to ensure consistency and professionalism:

- **Page Limit:** Abstracts should not exceed 1 page, with an optional up to 2 explanatory pages.
- **Font and Size:** Use Times New Roman, 11-point font for the main text.
- **Layout:** Single-column format with justified alignment.
- **Margins:** Set margins to 30 mm (top and left) and 25 mm (right and bottom) on A4 paper (210 mm x 297 mm).
- **Section Headings:** Format section headings in Times New Roman, 12-point bold, with subsections in 11-point bold.
- **Figures and Tables:** Not applicable for standard abstract submissions. If included, they must adhere to the rules specified in the full manuscript guidelines.

## ♣ Submission Instructions

All abstracts must be submitted as PDF files via the [Microsoft CMT](#) platform. The Abstract Submission Guidelines document provides detailed instructions on formatting and content requirements, and additional platform-specific guidance can be found on the [Microsoft CMT Author Help Page](#). Abstracts that do not meet the formatting requirements may be returned for revision or rejected.
