Professor of Mechanics at the University of Strasbourg, France

Is the Director of the Laboratory of Renewable Energies and Advanced Materials (LERMA) at the International University of Rabat (UIR) - Morocco. He is also a distinguished Professor of Mechanics at the University of Strasbourg – France and he holds an Adjunct Professor position with the School of Materials Science and Engineering at Georgia Institute of Technology, Atlanta – USA. He obtained his PhD and Habilitation from the University of Metz (now the University of Lorraine) in France. Dr. Said Ahzi held several positions worldwide including: 1- in the USA as Assistant and Associate Professor of Mechanical Engineering at Clemson University-SC, Research Scientist and Lecturer at the University of California at San Diego, and Postdoctoral Research Associate at the Mechanical Engineering Department, Massachusetts Institute of Technology-MIT; 2- in Qatar as Principal Investigator, Research Director and joint Professor at Qatar Environment and Energy Research Institute (QEERI) - Hamad Bin Khalifa University (HBKU); 3- Visiting/Adjunct Professor/Scientist at Texas A&M University, University of Aveiro – Portugal, Pohang University of Science and Technology – South Korea, University of Vienna – Austria, and Central South University – China.

Dr. Said Ahzi general area of research includes mechanics of materials, nanomaterials, composites, materials processing and manufacturing (including 3D printing), biomechanics, reliability of energy devices, and energy efficiency. He advised 37 PhDs and 25 Masters and was the scientific advisor/guarantor for six Habilitations. He published more than 350 scientific papers.
